



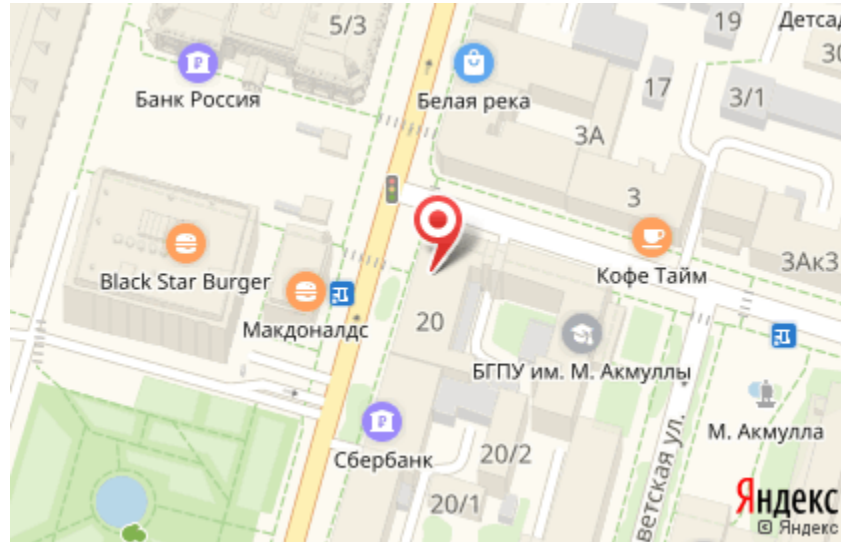

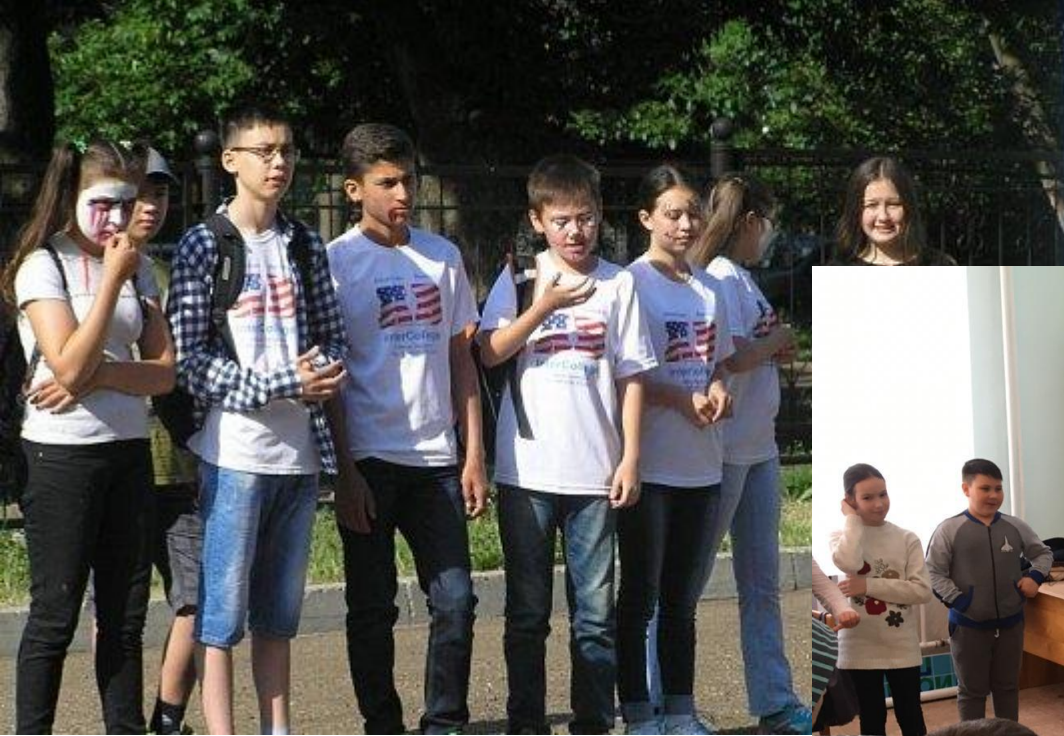


# INTERNATIONAL EDUCATIONAL PROGRAM “ACCESS”
